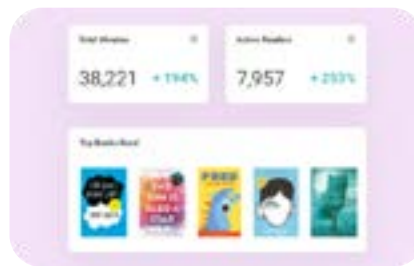
Build a culture of reading with Beanstack

Beanstack motivates your students to spend more time reading. Here are just a few ways you can use Beanstack to grow your students' reading habits:



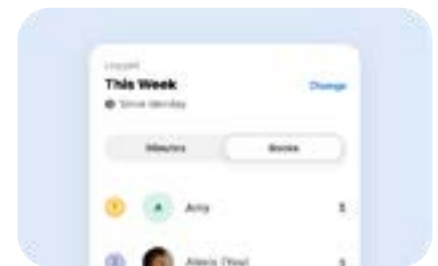
Build routine
